#### 2005 - 2006 - Rain Valley Ranch

Marketed, negotiated, and closed the sale of the Rain Valley Ranch which straddles the Cochise and Santa Cruz County line and includes the foothills of the Whetstone Mountains and the Mustang Mountains. Covenants were included on the phasing of development on the portions of the property and included a lease-back arrangement for agricultural purposes. #### 2003 - 2005 - Bar V Ranch
